AIMS OF THE ORGANIZATION:

The primary function of an organization is to offer a holy space where people can express their devotion to Hindu deities and worship them. At the Temple, devotees can seek blessings, participate in rituals, and establish a spiritual connection. Cultural traditions, such as festivals, music, dance, and art, are often greatly enriched and preserved by People. Kovil act as community centers where people gather for religious and social events, fostering a sense of community and belonging.

PRIME GOAL OF THE ORGANISATION:

The main goal of the organization is to provide a location for rituals, prayers, and ceremonies honoring different deities and to assist people in achieving enlightenment and spiritual development via devotion and meditation. Preserving and advancing religious and cultural customs via community events, lectures, and celebrations.

OBJECTIVES OF THE ORGANISATION:

The objectives of a organization are multifaceted and include social, cultural, and spiritual elements. These objectives involve encouraging the celebration of deities' festivals, special ceremonies, and daily rituals, as well as participating in humanitarian endeavors such as providing food for the underprivileged, offering healthcare, and promoting education.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF THE ORGANISATION:

Shri Mariamman Kovil is situated at Venkadareddiyur, Tamil Nadu. Shri Mariamman Kovil is the temple's name, and its history is stated below.

As per the oral tradition and going by the rituals conducted by the families (25 presently) associated with this temple, the temple dates back close to 1880 and even earlier. The Mariamman is the Kaaval Deivam or Goddess of Protection for all these families and some of them might have migrated or moved out in the past. In this region, Mariamman is the Kaaval Deivam (Protecting Deity) of many hamlets big and small and all Hindu families will have a family associated with their own Mariamman Temple named after the place in each Taluk or Village.

This region and surrounding places are known for the worship of Sakthi as a primordial Goddess of Protection and during the early 1900s until 1980 many family functions, and the first tonsuring of Hair of the child, ear piercing, and Aadi Month celebrations were conducted with lots of dedication and devotion in respective temples including Venkadareddiyur Shri Mariamman Temple.

During the late 80's the temple administration faced severe financial difficulty as the families were wholly dependent on Agricultural income. For unknown reasons they had to curtail some of the annual functions of the temple, however, the families connected to the temple made sure the temple was maintained, and it was functioning with minimal support.

With the support of the Villagers and the 25 families connected to the temple meeting was held in 2022 post covid to reinstate the glorious past of the Temple, as there were many health and other challenges imposed on the village and one of the reasons that was mentioned was that the Mariamman Temple was not taken care properly and that might be the reason for such hardships.

After consulting Hindu Priests, those who are experts in the field of Temple consecration, and the Hindu Almanac, the 25 families decided to renovate the temple as per the Shastras and due process such as Balalayam for the Thirumeni of the Amman was done. We also installed a Murti of Gaja Lakshmi while the renovation work was on and Gopuram work is in progress. By the Grace of Mariamman and Gaja Lakshmi, we hope to have the temple consecration / Kumbhabhishekam ceremony soon, which will become a place of Blessings, Peace and Prosperity for this region.



KOVIL CURRENT STATUS (November 2024):

In Venkadoreddiyur, we began renovation work on the Shri Mariamman Kovil in 2022. As of today, we have completed the construction of the Temple sanctum and gopuram. However, we still require donations for the remaining construction work, specifically for the mun mandapam, Vinayagar and Kada Kadappan Temple, Madapalli and Prakaram.

KOVIL GOPURAM:

Gopuram is the Main Temple Tower through which devotees enter the Temple premises. Gopuram is the tallest structure in the temple showcasing the presence of a Temple to the devotees.

VIMANAM:

This is the main structure that will be inside the temple walls where Sanctum Sanctorum is situated and in this sacred place the main deity of the Temple Shri Mariamman and other Deities for worship will be present. In Tamil Shri Mariamman Sannidhi will be and a medium size pyramid shaped structure showcasing the significance of the main deity, rituals, tradition and cultural aspect connected to the temple.

Gopuram and Vimanam are identical in shape, with one Tall and One small with distinct features reflected in the figurines on the structure as decided by the Temple Architect called Sthapathi after considering the local traditions and cultures related to the deity.

THIRUMADAPALLI / ANNAPOORANI STHALAM:

This is a unique kitchen where the everyday Prasadam for Naivedhyam is prepared for the God's. After the offering to all the God's in the temple, this Prasadam is distributed to the devotees present. This is one of the most blessed and sacred places as Food in our tradition is considered Goddess Annapoorna, and we seek the help of all devotees to make this place unique with all the facility to cater to the needs of preparing Prasadam every day, with utmost hygiene and safety.

MANDAPAM:

We are planning to have a nice Mandapam for hosting Spiritual and Cultural events associated with our Bhakthi culture. We are planning to have this Mandapam hopefully having activities throughout the year with Kalakshepam, Lectures on our Dharma, Classes for Kids on Tamil Bhakti Literature and Thevaram, Thiruvagasam, Thiruppugaz classes for the local kids and adults. This Mandapam, will be an open air Mandapam, and it will be put into good use for the sake of upkeep of the temple and activities associated with the Temple as per our Shastras.

1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT:

A. Project Overview:

This project aims to construct a comprehensive Hindu temple complex that includes a Kovil (main temple) with a Gopuram (tower), Maha Mandapam (great hall), Vinayagar Temple, Kadakadappa Temple, Madapalli (temple kitchen), Mandapam (function hall), and Kalyanakatta (hair offering place), Washroom, Pushkarni (Water Tank). The temple complex will serve as a spiritual, cultural, and community centre for devotees and visitors.

B. Objectives:

- **Spiritual Hub:** To create a sacred space for worship and spiritual activities.
- **Cultural Preservation:** To preserve and promote traditional Hindu architecture and rituals.
- **Community Engagement:** To provide a venue for community gatherings, cultural events, and social functions.

C. Key Components:

1. **Kovil (Main Temple):** Featuring a Gopuram and Maha Mandapam, dedicated to the primary deity.
2. **Vinayagar Temple:** A separate shrine for Lord Ganesha.
3. **Kadakadappa Temple:** Dedicated to a specific deity or purpose as per local traditions.
4. **Madapalli (Temple Kitchen):** For preparing and distributing prasadam (sacred food).
5. **Mandapam (Function Hall):** For hosting cultural and social events.
6. **Kalyanakatta (Hair Offering Place):** A designated area for devotees to offer their hair as a form of devotion.
7. **Pushkarni (Water Tank):** Natural spring-based water tanks attached to temples. Often used for ritual bathing and purification.

D. Project Timeline:

The project is expected to be completed within 48 months (4 years) from the start date (April 2022), with phased construction to ensure continuous progress and timely completion.

E. Budget Estimate:

The estimated budget for the entire project is INR 92 lakh, covering construction, materials, labour, and other associated costs.

11. KOVIL (MAIN TEMPLE):

Featuring a Garbhagriha, Gopuram and Maha Mandapam, dedicated to the primary deity. Garbhagriha also known as the “womb chamber,” it is the innermost sanctum of all temples. Here, the primary deity is worshipped in the form of a stone idol. Only priests have access to this holiest part of the temple. These temples are not only places of worship but also architectural marvels that evoke serenity and enlightenment.

12. MANDAPAM (FUNCTION HALL)

Kovil Mandapam is a place in Venkadarreddiyur, Tamil Nadu, India. The Function Hall for hosting cultural and social events. Also, we intend to offer broad extra-curricular activities, such as Yoga, Silambam, and karate, to school children and other village residents who are eager to participate.

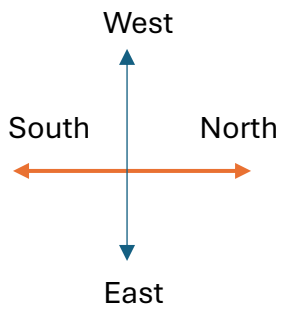

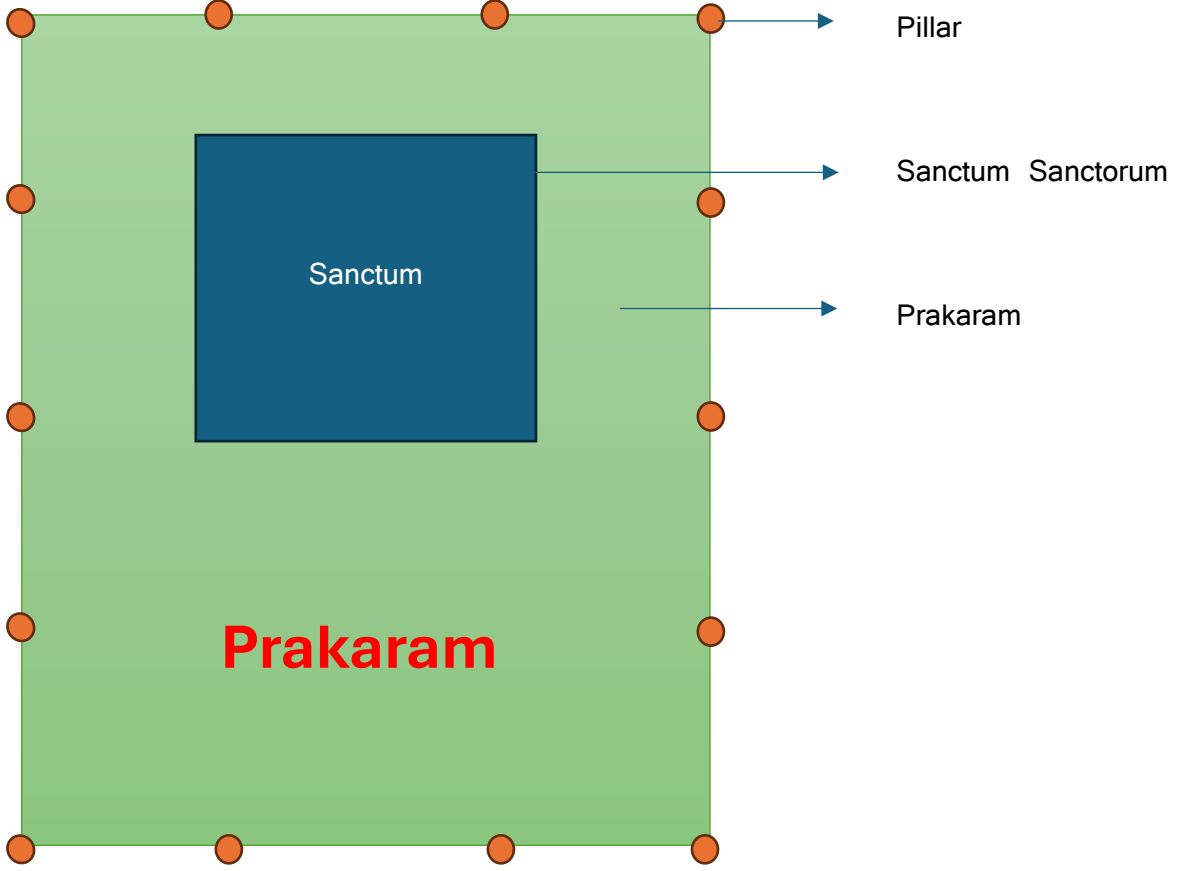

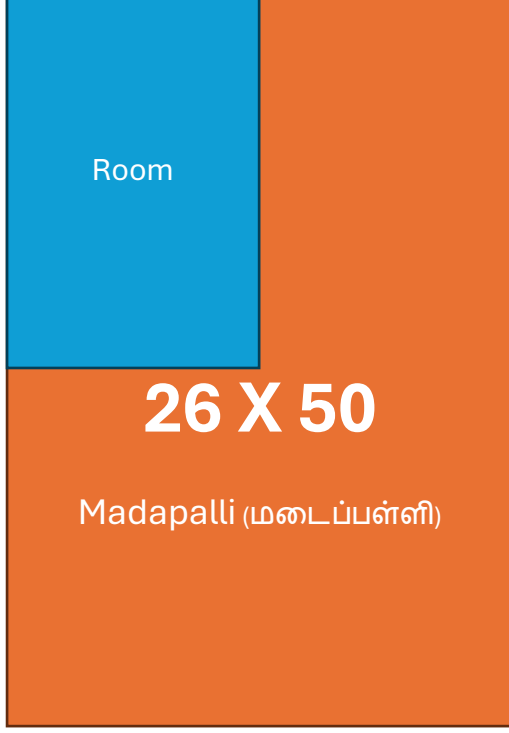
